The training covered critical aspects of first aid, including:

- Basic life support (BLS)
- CPR techniques
- Handling fractures, burns, and wounds
- Emergency response during accidents
- Importance of timely medical intervention

The session was highly interactive, featuring practical demonstrations and hands-on practice for participants. Community members, including youth, women, and elderly citizens, actively engaged with the trainer, showing great enthusiasm in learning life-saving procedures.

The ISR Cell of AVIT, through this effort, reinforced its commitment to social responsibility by fostering a safer, more prepared rural community.
